Certainly! Assessments bring valuable insight. They can be used to enhance an individual's potential through evaluation of knowledge, skills, emotional intelligence, academic abilities, and occupational performance. In the clinical setting, psychological testing can provide vital diagnostic information to treatment providers about an individual's intelligence, personality characteristics, coping skills, symptoms and response to treatment.

The Whole-Person Approach to Assessment

Psychological problems are often complex and difficult to understand. Often, the first step in successful treatment is a thorough assessment with a gathering of life history, presenting problems, and co-occurring symptoms. Through Prepare to Change, experienced psychologists and doctoral students in clinical psychology conduct these in-person interviews over the course of one to two hours.

Occasionally, a single-purpose test is administered, but more frequently, a battery of several tests is designed to shed light on the cause of symptoms and to guide treatment. Based on the specific assessment battery, the test taker completes standardized questionnaires through online, verbal, or written methods. Finally, a written and well-informed report is delivered based on the assessment purpose along with a thorough explanation of results.
